SKOZI OBJEKTIV NEZNANEGA VOJAKA / THROUGH THE LENS OF AN UNKNOWN SOLDIER

Edinstvena razstava s Praškega gradu, vas skozi reprodukcije redkih fotografij češkega fotografa in vojaka, ki se je bojeval na italijanski fronti med 1. svetovno vojno, popelje na Doberdobski kras in soško fronto. Razstava torej predstavlja posebno zbirko posnetkov, ki so nastali deloma tudi na slovenskem ozemlju; obiskovalcem pa ponuja vpogled v vsakdanje življenje vojakov 1. svetovne vojne. The unique exhibition from the Prague Castle will take you to Doberdò Karst and the Soča (Isonzo) River Front through the reproductions of rare photographs by a Czech photographer and soldier who fought on the Italian front during World War I. The exhibition presents a special collection of images that were created partially on Slovenian territory, and visitors will be offered an insight into the everyday reality of the soldiers participating in World War I through the eyes of a genuine soldier. Grajski dnevi

Castle Days

16. maja leta 1905 je mesto Ljubljana pod županom Ivanom Hribarjem odkupilo Ljubljanski grad od deželnih oblasti. Na Ljubljanskem gradu bomo poslej ta dan obeleževali kot dan gradu, in tako obiskovalcem vsako leto znova ponudili različne vsebine. V letošnjem maju bomo »praznovali« že dan prej in še dan po tem.

V nedeljo, 15. maja, bomo na široko odprli grajska vrata in obiskovalce povabili na vodeni sprehod po grajskem podzemlju. Pri rednih vodstvih si teh prostorov ne morete ogledati, vendar pa so nujno potrebni za nemoteno delovanje grajskih poslopij. Na ta dan si bodo obiskovalci lahko ogledali tudi Razgledni stolp in razstavo Slovenska zgodovina ter Virtualni muzej, katerega desetletnico delovanja praznujemo prav maja letos; v letu 2001 ga je prebivalcem in obiskovalcem Ljubljane podarila Tobačna Ljubljana, v desetih letih si ga je ogledalo že več kot milijon obiskovalcev. V ponedeljek, 16. maja, bomo na Ljubljanski grad povabili najmlajše in šolarje. Njim je namenjena predstava Sentsjakobskega gledališča Dogodivščine dvornega norčka Ferdinanda in delavnica po njej. Torek, 17. maja, pa vabljene vsi, ki vas zanima prenova in oživitvev Ljubljanskega gradu. Tine Horvat, vodja arheoloških raziskav, mag. Dušan Kramberger, nekdanji glavni konservator, Majda Kregar in Miha Kerin, dva od projektantov prenove, bodo predstavili opravljene strokovne raziskave, konservatorske opredelitve, celovito zasnovano namembnosti za oživitvev gradu in griča ter nekatere funkcionalne in oblikovne rešitve. Vsi navedeni programi, ki bodo potekali na Ljubljanskem gradu med 15. in 17. majem, bodo brezplačni. Vabljene!

On 16 May 1905, under the guidance of Mayor Ivan Hribar, the city of Ljubljana purchased the Ljubljana Castle from the provincial authorities. From 2011 on, we will mark this day at the Ljubljana Castle as the Day of the Castle, offering visitors a range of events each year. In May this year, we will also “celebrate” on the day before and the day after 16 May.

On Sunday 15 May, we will open the castle gates wide and invite visitors on a guided walk through the castle's underground. These spaces cannot be viewed during regular guided tours, but they are essential for the undisturbed operation of the castle complex. On this day, visitors will also be able to view the Viewing Tower and the Slovene History Exhibition, as well as the Virtual Museum, which actually celebrates ten years of operation in May this year; in 2001, the museum was donated to the inhabitants and visitors of Ljubljana by Tobačna Ljubljana, and over the past ten years it has been viewed by more than a million visitors. On Monday 16 May, we will invite young ones and school children to the Ljubljana Castle, offering them a performance in the St Jacob's Theatre entitled The Adventures of Ferdinand the Court Jester, followed by a workshop. Tuesday 17 May is dedicated to everyone who is interested in the renovation and regeneration of the Ljubljana Castle. Tine Horvat, head of archaeological research, Dušan Kramberger, the former head conservator, and Majda Kregar and Miha Kerin, two of the designers of the renovation, will present the specialised research undertaken, the conservator's expert report, the overall scheme of the objectives of the regeneration of the castle and the castle hill, as well as certain functional and design solutions. All of the events taking place at the Ljubljana Castle between 15 and 17 May will be presented free of charge. You are warmly welcome!

Bogdana Herman z gosti na Ljubljanskem gradu

Bogdana Herman and Guests at the Ljubljana Castle

Cikel petih koncertov Bogdane Herman z gosti bo na različnih prizoriščih Ljubljanskega gradu potekal med majem in decembrom. Bogdana Herman poje brez glasbene spremljave v glavnem tiste slovenske ljudske pesmi, ki obstajajo v notnih zapisih – objavljenih ali neobjavljenih, ljudje pa so jih že pozabili. Poje pesmi iz vseh slovenskih pokrajin ter iz italijanskega, avstrijskega, madžarskega in čezmorskega »zamejstva«. Posebej jo veseli interpretacija ljubezenskih in pripovednih pesmi, v katerih išče prtajene vzporednice evropskega izročila in zgodovine Zemlje. Na prvem koncertu 20. maja bomo v grajski kapeli sv. Jurija slišali zelo redko izvajane najstarejše slovenske ljudske pesmi. Pripovedne pesmi iz Rezije, Porabja, Gorenjske, Dolenjske, Bele krajine, Koroške in Primorske bodo dajale mogočen okvir nežnim ljubezenskim, žalostne se bodo obračale k veselim, preteklost k prihodnosti. V prodaji so vstopnice za posamezni koncert ali za celoten glasbeni cikel.

A cycle of five concerts by Bogdana Herman and guests will take place at various venues at the Ljubljana Castle from May to December. Bogdana Herman sings without instrumental accompaniment and her repertoire encompasses primarily Slovene folk songs that exist in notated form, both published and unpublished, but that have been forgotten by the people. She sings songs from all of the regions of Slovenia, as well as songs of Slovene populations in Italy, Austria and Hungary, and of Slovenes living overseas. Bogdana Herman takes particular pleasure in interpreting love songs and narrative songs, in which she seeks parallels between the European tradition and the history of the Earth. At the first concert in the Castle Chapel of St George on 20 May, we will hear some of the oldest Slovene folk songs, which are rarely heard today. Narrative songs from Rezija, Porabje, Gorenjska, Dolenjska, Bela krajina, Koroška and Primorska will provide a powerful frame for gentle love songs, sad songs will turn to joyous songs, and the past to the future. Tickets are available either for individual concerts or for the entire cycle.


