Gradovi že od nekdaj burijo našo domišljijo. S svojo pomembnostjo in veljavo ter s svojo mogočnostjo in trdnostjo nas ponosno opozarjajo na preteklo vlogo varuhov dežel, mest in meja, pa tudi svojih, praviloma plemenitih, stanovalcev.

Grajski zidovi varujejo številne zgodbe in legende, ki so se spletle okrog njih in se globoko zasidrale v naši zavesti. Največkrat v razvalinah, le redko ohranjeni ali celo vzdrževani, so srednjeveški gradovi še dandanes sopomenka za tisti odmaknjeni čas, ki ga navadno označujemo z besedo fevdalizem, čeprav so gradovi pravzaprav nastajali le v njegovi zreli dobi, od 11.

stoletja dalje do začetka nove dobe, nakar so jih zamenjali v dolinah, na ravnicah postavljeni udobnejši dvorci.

Osrednja tematska razstava Ljubljanskega gradu v letu 2019 Slovenijo prikazuje kot deželo gradov. Razstava z izpostavljivo petih slovenskih gradov in z njimi povezanimi osebnostmi, ki so zaznamovale našo preteklost, ter z raznolikim fotografskim gradivom in maketami osvetljuje bogato zapuščino, ki so jo gradovi skozi stoletja ohraniali.

Razstava je posvečena spominu dr. Ivana Stoparja, umetnostnega zgodovinarja, konservatorja in kastelologa, ki je s svojim

večdesetletnim izvirnim in strastnim delom slovensko grajsko dedičino znova približal ljudem.

Castles have always stirred our imagination. Irrespective of their importance and renown, castles, with their might and solidity, from up close or from afar proudly draw our attention to their past role as guardians of the countryside, cities and borders, and of their mainly noble inhabitants.

Within their walls, castles also guard many stories and legends that weave around them and are deeply embedded in our consciousness. Most often in ruins, only rarely preserved or even maintained, medieval castles are still synonymous with that distant time usually referred to as feudalism, although castles were actually created only in the mature feudal age, from the eleventh century to the beginning of the Early Modern Period, when they were replaced by more comfortable mansions in the valleys and on the plains.

The central thematic exhibition at the Ljubljana Castle in 2019 reveals Slovenia as a country of castles. With its exposé of five Slovenian castles and their associated personalities who marked Slovenia's past, and with various photographic material and models, the exhibition illuminates the

rich heritage that has been preserved for us through the centuries by castles.

The exhibition is dedicated to the memory of art historian, conservator and castle expert Ivan Stopar, PhD, who, with his decades of original and passionate work, brought the Slovenian castle heritage closer to people.

## Fridrik Prvi – pregnana podgana in njegova ukana/

## Fridrik the First – A Fugitive Rat and His Tricks

(za otroke od 5. leta dalje/for children aged

Na Ljubljanskem gradu prebiva grajska podgana, ki sliši na ime Fridrik Prvi. Najpogosteje ga najdemo v grajski ječi, kjer so mu jetniki zaupali prenekatero zgodbo. Pozna tudi veliko grajskih skrivnosti, saj je med bivanjem na gradu spoznal Erazma Predjamskega in samega cesarja Fridrika III. Habsburškega.

Cesarjevi služabniki so mu povedali veliko junaških in ljubezenskih zgodb. Sam je bolj zaljubljen v dišeče kuhrske umetnije, ki jih peče grajska kuharica, vendar je to povsem druga zgodba.

Vsak, ki je dovolj radoveden, ga lahko še dandanes najde za grajskim obzidjem, včasih za seboj pusti le svoje stopinje ... Ker pa rad deli svoje znanje, lahko včasih najdemo njegove namige, ki nas popeljejo v raziskovanje skritih kotičkov gradu in grajske preteklosti. Je mogoče, da takšno

raziskovanje ni dogodivščina, ampak ukana? Če ste vsaj malo radovedni, se boste prepričali na svoje oči. Si upate?

At the Ljubljana Castle, there lives a castle rat who answers to the name Fridrik the First. He is most commonly found in the castle penitentiary, where the prisoners shared many a story with him in the past. He also knows a lot of the castle's secrets, as during his stay at the castle he has met Erasmus of Lueg and Emperor Frederick III of Habsburg himself. Habsburg. The Emperor's servants told him many stories of heroism and love. However, Fridrik himself is more in love with the fragrant masterpieces of cuisine created by the castle cook ... but that is another story altogether.

Anyone who is sufficiently curious can still find Fridrik behind the castle walls today. Sometimes he only leaves his own footprints behind him ... Because he likes to share his knowledge, we can sometimes find clues he has left to lead us to explore the hidden corners of the castle and its past. Could it be that these explorations are not an adventure, but a trick? If you are just a little curious, you will see the evidence with your own eyes. Do you dare?
